The Port of Depoe Bay is a public facility located in and run by the City of Depoe Bay on the central Oregon coast. It is a town of approximately 1,200 residents and home to a U.S. Coast Guard station. Primarily a charter boat and commercial fishing community, Depoe Bay is also a popular tourist stop with resorts, motels, restaurants, shops and galleries, and whale watching activities. At any one time during the vacation calendar there may be 4,500 or more people in town. The City of Depoe Bay is located in the Depoe Bay Rural Fire Protection District and the Lincoln County Emergency Services area. The City conducts the administration of the city, is responsible for the water, sewer, street and storm water drainage systems, as well as the Depoe Bay harbor and its facilities.
