- 5. Please describe the requesting organization's main activities, and whether it is a public, private non-profit, or private for-profit entity:** Garibaldi is an incorporated small city.
- 6. Briefly describe the activity or project for which funding is requested (please keep to 500 words or less.)** The city has had plans on hand but has been awaiting funding for actual construction. 100% of the funds will go towards construction and equipment including commercial range and hood, upgrade of 1950s-era restrooms and kitchen, creation of storage for Red Cross amenities. This is the only emergency management facility in this part of Tillamook County. This facility supports the Garibaldi Fire Department, the Tillamook County Sheriff's Office (Garibaldi deputy), Garibaldi Rural Fire District and Red Cross operations.
